- ❖ State Approval Received: We recently received state approval for the Certificate of Achievement in Humanities, which was approved by the CCC in December, 2016. Efforts continue in order to secure articulation with USF.
- ❖ New Department Code: The Language Arts division has approved a new department code of Non-Credit College Skills (NCCN). This new code will go into effect for the 2017-18 catalog and will initially house one new course (which has been developed under the code of IDS 406).
- TracDat System Upgrade: TracDat is being upgraded to a new version, with a more user-friendly interface, resulting in the discontinuation of the version currently in use at Foothill. The conversion is scheduled for Thursday, March 30th, with setup of the new version occurring during the first week of April.
