- 3. Other (non-action) items
 - a) SOSC 79 Sam Connell is the author of record and, we believe, has adjusted this course for use in the Anthropology summer overseas programs (Ireland, Ecuador...). For lab credit students must be in line-of-sight by the instructor so this may work for his plans. Daphne Small also would like to use this course however the line-of-sight requirement means she cannot use it as she has proposed (students serving off-campus internships. Daphne believes there is something similar at DeAnza ... Kurt and Daphne are looking into what exactly DeAnza is doing. Assuming the DeAnza model does not fit this course Kurt suggests Daphne create a 1-unit lecture (SOSC 78?) and have the students enroll in a for-credit internship class (already existing) to achieve her goal.
 - b) PSYC 54H Clarification on repeatability: The active COR correctly states that this course is not repeatable.
 - c) Falk is concerned that she may not be able to offer HUMN 3H as it is in staging. Bill will follow up with an email to Mary V and Becki to clarify if/when it can be taught.
 - d) There were concerns / questions about new course MTEC 84D (Psychology of Music) overlap with PSYC.. why MTEC? The PSYC department has been notified and should consult the course author (with Kurt).
 - e) BSS faculty need to do a SOSC Comprehensive Program Review ... maybe the new BSS department heads? Faculty are responsible for doing this Kurt will stay on top of this.
 - f) Ask Mary when she thinks the list of courses that will require Title V updates will come out.
 - g) We have Gerontology curriculum that we are not offering... so we either need to get it organized or deactivate.
