The Global Studies proposal prompted a discussion about creating an AA degree for the discipline or converting the General Studies/Social Sciences degree to a Global Studies emphasis. Patricia Gibbs detailed a database she is compiling (as a fellow of the EPIC program) with information about Global Studies programs worldwide.

Kathryn Maurer shared that the Global Studies proposal will get first and second reads at PARC and CCC over the next four weeks. Kathryn also stated that it is likely that state approval of the Global Studies ADT will be delayed until the state assigns a CSU reader for the program.
