Discussion

Concern regarding the seat count of 50 students in an honors class was raised. The high seat count negatively impacts student achievement. It was proposed to coordinate a meeting with the Faculty Association (FA) to discuss the process of lowering the seat count, particularly for an honors course.

Item 7 on the COR includes representative texts for the course. Concern was expressed that students have purchased a textbook for the course based on the COR rather than the syllabus, which could have a different text. It was suggested that the COR have language suggesting students contact the instructor of record for textbook information.
