- 2. The board approved the policy.
- 3. There was discussion about the definitions. 2 general comments were made: there should be a publicized deadline for non-state approved certificates to become approved, and after that they are sorted into either approved (Academic Program) or not approved. Also, there should be a separate process under Academic Programs for "orphan departments," or departments that do not offer a degree or certificate, but do have courses that support degrees and/or certificates.
- 4. The comprehensive template will be shared and worked on this month, and finalized/approved by PaRC before the year ends.
- 5. The budget assignment from PaRC seems to be a request to provide feedback on the guiding principles that were updated by OPC this year. They were updated through the lens of resource allocation, but were not updated with big budget reductions in mind. IP&B will hold a retreat to work on this assignment and provide recommendations to PaRC.
