RE: Teaching and Learning Center (TLC) Use Survey Results, Winter 2017

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#### Overview

Students who accessed the Teaching and Learning Center (TLC) in Fall 2016 and Winter 2017 were surveyed at the end of the Winter 2017 quarter to determine their satisfaction with the services currently being offered. Survey administration occurred over one week, between March 23 to March 30, 2017, and yielded a 10% response rate (180 students responding out of a total of 1,790).

#### Highlights

- Respondents stated that their primary reason(s) for not using the Teaching and Learning Center (TLC) more often were because they had trouble scheduling individual tutoring appointments (13%), the TLC hours are inconvenient (12%), and Other (24%). Note that the majority of the “Other” responses were due to not needing it this quarter, studying elsewhere, and disliking the environment at the TLC.
- Of the 5 students who responded that the TLC was not open when needed, 44% wished the TLC were open after 4PM on Fridays, while another 44% wished the TLC was open before 8AM (22%) and after 7PM (22%) on Monday-Thursdays.
- A little less than half (48%) of the respondents utilized individual tutoring at the TLC, another 47% reported using the study rooms (27%) and printing services (20%). A much smaller group of students indicated they attended the group workshops (5%).
- The majority of students who participated in individual tutoring reported dropping into the TLC (81%) rather than making an appointment (19%). For those who experienced difficulty with the online appointment system, most had trouble with finding available dates (29%), not having enough appointment dates available (29%) and not being able to get the tutor they want (29%).
- The majority of students (12) who participated in the group workshops indicated that they were offered at times convenient to their schedule (75%). Of the 4 students who indicated group workshop day and times to be inconvenient, they responded to most likely attending a group workshop on weekday afternoons/nights (PM): Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays (57%) and Tuesdays & Thursdays (29%).
- Other workshops titles students would like offered include resume writing and speech (including pronunciation and accent reduction).

- The majority of respondents do not think the TLC needs more study space (study rooms, tables, chairs, etc.) (66%).
- Almost all the respondents can print in other locations outside of the TLC (97%).
- When asked what they would change about the TLC to make it more useful, many responses included more outlets (near the back, center, and tutoring tables) and longer time with tutors.

### Methodology

Remark survey software was used to develop and administer the use survey, which occurred between Thursday March 23, 2017 - Thursday March 30, 2017. Students who accessed the TLC in the Fall 2016 and Winter 2017 quarter were identified through SARS.

A small error in the survey occurred where an extra 36 students were asked questions about their experiences with TLC group workshops, although these students did not checkmark having utilized this service. In order to represent the data clearly, these 36 student responses were removed from the group workshop question tables, leaving only the responses of those who have actually utilized the TLC group workshops.




1. How often do you use the Teaching and Learning Center?




2. Generally speaking, is the Teaching and Learning Center open when you need it?





3.1a. Do you usually make an appointment or drop-in for individual tutoring?




3.1b. Do you think that time spent in individual tutoring increased the likelihood that you will receive a higher grade/a grade you want?


3.1c. Do you think that time spent in individual tutoring has helped improve your understanding of concepts in your class?





3.2a. Are the workshops offered at times convenient to your schedule?




3.2b. Do you think that time spent in the group workshops increased the likelihood that you will receive a higher grade/a grade you want?






3.2e. Please select which day and time you would be most likely to attend a TLC group workshop. (Check all that apply)


3.3a. Do you feel that the TLC needs more study space (study rooms, tables, chairs, etc.)?

3.4a. Other than the TLC, are there places where you can print?



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


5. Are there any changes you would make to the Teaching and Learning Center that would make it more useful to you?

- "Some tutors don't have good attitude towards students, are not willing to assist students."
- "The time could be adjusted a little bit."
- "More tutors and at least 30 minutes per student. 20 minutes is not enough."
