2. Social Entrepreneur Club (Student Club) – Y. Yukina reviewed the Social Entrepreneur Club's sustainability survey with the group. Out of 272 responses, it clearly told us we need to communicate more about programs on campus and there are some students that would be willing to assist projects/events on campus. A suggestion was made for bicycle repair stations on the campus, security cameras and Ulock storage. We will look into this in the spring quarter. 5. The District has attempted 3 times to hire an Energy Manager. The committee will be going out a fourth time in the near future.

6. Energy Update – B. Cormia presented the campus utility bills and trends. Foothill is statistically “flat” over the past 5-6 years. B. Cormia discussed his Energy Champion program, and the involvement student roles can have on influencing human behavior and environmental efficiency.
