RE: Campus Climate (Title IX) Survey Results

Overview

Survey results from an online survey were analyzed to document student perceptions about the campus climate, especially regarding issues and concerns related to Title IX. The survey was administered to all registered students, and 226 respondents completed the survey. Responses to all completed questions can be found in the appendix.

Highlights: Demographics

- The majority of student respondents identify as:
 - Between ages 18 to 29 (82%);
 - Female (59%);
 - not Hispanic/Latinx (76%); and
 - Heterosexual (straight) (69%).
- Almost half of the students are in their first year at Foothill (42%), while another 29% reported being in their second year. For most respondents, their academic experience translates to roughly 2-3 quarters of enrollment (39%).
- Over half of the students report being enrolled in a mix of face-to-face and online courses (60%).

Highlights: General Climate

- While the majority of students believe faculty, staff, and administrators respect what students think (86%) and treat them fairly (80%), fewer students believe the college employees are genuinely concerned about their welfare (75%). Over half of students believe there is good support system on campus for those going through difficult times, yet another one-third are neutral/ambivalent (60% vs. 34%). Correspondingly, less than half of respondents report feeling close to people at Foothill (41%) and one-third feeling natural/ambivalent (32%).
- Students generally feel safe at Foothill, with 89% agreeing at some level with this statement. This belief appears reinforced by the 61% who also “agree” or “strongly agree” that the college does enough to protect the safety of students.
- The majority of students are happy to be at Foothill (85%) but only half report they feel a part of Foothill (56%). In fact, a higher rate “neither agree nor disagree” or “disagree” that they feel close to people at Foothill, compared to those who “agree” or “strongly agree” with that statement (52% vs. 41%).

Highlights: College Responsiveness

- More than half of the students feel neutral/are ambivalent about whether college officials should do more to protect students from hard (56%), perhaps because they believe the college would handle a campus crisis well (63%).
- In general, students believe Foothill would act responsively regarding sexual assault, supporting student reporting (88%); demonstrating confidentiality (84%); addressing factors that may have led to the incident (82%); and taking corrective action against the offender (78%).
- Although students did express concern that retaliation against the person making the report would be at least somewhat likely (62%), they did feel their peers would be “extremely likely” or “moderately likely” to support the reporter (74%).

Highlights: Sexual Assault Training

- The majority of student respondents have not received training in the prevention of sexual assault (73%) or in sexual assault policies and procedures (68%). The lack of training may be related to two-thirds of students indicating a limited understanding of Foothill’s formal procedures in addressing sexual assault complaints (66%). For those who did report participating in training, 69% felt the experience was “very” or “moderately” useful.

Highlights: Sexual Assault Experiences

- Roughly 4% reported experiencing forced sexual contact, mainly related to forced touching of a sexual nature (half of those reporting). Almost all these experiences were not reported to involve drugs (whether voluntary (95%) or not (94%)) or alcohol (89%); however, among incidents that did involve alcohol, over one-third reported that both parties were using this substance. The alleged offender was typically not a Foothill student (74%) nor employee (97%), but rather an ex-romantic partner, stranger, acquaintance or non-romantic friend (75%). Therefore, more incidents were reported to have occurred in the home setting (student, alleged offender, friends).
- Students tended to tell close friends if they experienced a sexual assault experience (42%). Among students chose not to tell anyone, they felt: (1) they wanted to forget it happened; (2) ashamed/embarrassed; (3) others wouldn't think it was serious; (4) they would be blamed for what happened; (5) it was a private matter and wanted to deal with it on their own; and (6) nothing would be done.
- Only 2 students reported using formal procedures to report the incident(s) but felt mixed regarding whether it helped them deal with the problem.

Methodology

The online survey was administered to all registered students in Spring 2017, who received an email invite with the survey link embedded from Marketing and Public Relations. The survey was created using Advocate software and administered from March 20, 2017 to May 6, 2017. The response rate was roughly 2%, with 226 completed surveys from a population of 12,531 (credit census).




Q1 Which campus do you take the majority of your classes?



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






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Q7 Which term best describes your sexual orientation?





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Q9 What was your first academic year at Foothill College?





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
Q11 I know where to go to get help.

Q12 I feel valued in the classroom/learning environment.



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
Q13 Faculty, staff, and administrators respect what students on this campus think.




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Q15 I feel close to people at Foothill.





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
Q17 I am happy to be at Foothill College.




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Q19 I feel safe at Foothill.






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Q21 If a crisis happened on campus, my college would handle it well.





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
Q23 College officials handle incidents in a fair and responsible manner.




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Q25 There is a good support system on campus for students going through difficult times.






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Q27 The college would take steps to support and protect the safety of the person making the report.






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Q29 The college would take corrective action against the offernder.






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Q31 Students would label the person making the report a troublemaker.






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Q33 The alleged offender(s) or their associates would retaliate against the person making the report.










Q37 I understand Foothill College's formal procedures to address complaints of sexual assault.

Q38 I have confidence that Foothill College administers the formal procedures to address complaints of sexual assault fairly.








Q43 What was the gender of the individual who did this to you?












