



Student Contract

The Umoja Learning Community at Foothill College, a first-year support program for students who want to transfer, is designed for students beginning classes in the fall quarter. Our class offerings are transferable to CSU/UC and range from English, communications, math, social sciences and STEM. Umoja students should enroll in at least 6 units of Umoja classes each quarter, maintain a 2.0 cumulative grade point average and attend classes regularly as well as Umoja sponsored events.

During and after the first year, we also offer community meetings, an Umoja Club, and on & off campus cultural, academic, and service learning events.

Student Partnership with the Umoja Community

The Umoja community offers many benefits such as book vouchers, high-touch academic counseling, school supplies, academic support, mentoring, college tours, cultural events, free conferences, student service learning, leadership opportunities, African-American focused curriculum, student-run village space on campus, food pantry, Umoja club events, and a tight-knit community.

Student Expectations

- Attend all classes regularly
- Prioritize and attend Umoja events/meetings
- Earn at least a C in all Umoja classes
- Complete Progress Reports and maintain a 2.0 cumulative grade point average
- Appropriate classroom behavior—no verbal or physical disruptions.
- Meet with your academic counselor Tracee Cunningham three times a quarter.

I understand that if I am unable to fulfill the above expectations, then depending on the frequency and severity of the issue or event, the consequence will range from required meetings with counselors to expulsion from the program.
