- PO Authorization (Ch. 31/VRE)-please check with your VRE Counselor
- Financial Aid (FAFSA) Confirmation page
- Signed Student Responsibility Form

#### Schedule an appointment with the veterans counselor

Must complete a Veterans Education Plan for Veteran Educational Benefits
Submit a Request for Enrollment Certification form AFTER you have met with the Veteran
Resource Center Counselor

### To remain eligible for Priority Registration you must:

- Declare a major and select a goal in My Portal
- Complete a New Student Orientation
- Have an education plan in DegreeWorks that includes classes for the quarter you want priority registration
- Meet the state requirements for priority registration (i.e. 2.0 GPA, less than 100 attempted credits)
