Application Deadline: April 21st, 2018 at 11:59pm PDT

Our Veterinary Technology Application is now ONLY available online. Please make sure that you give yourself enough time to read through the instructions so that you can submit a complete application, by the deadline.

Please follow the instructions below in order to submit your 2018 Veterinary Technology Application:

Before you apply

1. Please visit the Veterinary Technology website and read the available information.

2. In order to apply to the Veterinary Technology Program, you must obtain a campus wide identification number or CWID. If you don't have a CWID, you may obtain one by submitting an application to Foothill College, at no cost to you. Required Documents: Please obtain copies of the following documents, and be prepared to upload them and attach them to your application.

- Official Electronic Transcripts (e-transcripts) from ALL colleges attended, except for Foothill and De Anza Colleges.

Additional Documents: You are welcome to include the following documents, if they apply to you, or you would like to include them with your application.

- **Approved** petitions (required if applicable)
- Math Placement results
- Documentation of completion of CSU or IGETC General education
- Cover letter

Transcripts

Due to the transition of our application system, if you are a previous applicant you must submit all new official electronic transcripts to Foothill College Admissions and Records.

Official Foothill College and/or De Anza College transcripts are not required. If you have prerequisite coursework completed from Foothill College or De Anza College you must enter the coursework where appropriate on the application. We can verify your successful completion of that coursework internally.

You should obtain your College Transcripts by requesting a copy from all the Colleges you've attended. Typically, registrar offices or registration departments at the corresponding college will assist you with this. Please note that unofficial copies will not be accepted and may automatically disqualify you. For the 2018 application, you must request that electronic transcripts or e-transcripts be sent to Foothill College Admissions and Records. Remember that if you received an Associate's Degree from a California Community College and/or Bachelor's degree from a UC or CSU, completion of your General Education requirements will be waived.

You will have to submit an Equivalency Petition Form through our counseling department, if you have completed prerequisite coursework outside of Foothill College, and the course/s you have completed is/are not included in the Veterinary Technology Equivalency Form. If this is the case, please download the form, fill it out, include documentation supporting your petition, and make an appointment with a Foothill counselor.
