



# Starting Proctorio Test.

Proctorio is a remote proctoring software which, when installed in your web browser, monitors the test takers.

**Note: Proctorio only works on Google Chrome**


When you're taking an exam for the first time with a new computer or in a new location, you should always try this practice test.

Just take your exam as usual, in the exam window your professor has set up, just try not to wait until the last second :-).

**Let's get started!**

Step 1: If you don't have Proctorio already installed in your web browser (Chrome), this thing will pop up on your Canvas Screen.

### Instructions

This practice test ensures your computer is ready to take a remotely proctored exam.

Instruction for the actual midterm exam:

This exam is **closed book, closed notes, no calculator, no laptop, no netbook, no mobile and personal devices, no cell phone, no 3rd party communication, no talking, et cetera**. You will **only** use **blank** scratch paper, Canvas/Java Code Critic via **Chrome**, MS Office or LibreOffice, a text editor like Notepad or TextEdit, and a dictionary and/or thesaurus like <https://www.merriam-webster.com> . You will **not use any Java environment (such as JGRASP or Eclipse)**. Unless directed otherwise, you will submit answers and Java code from only your **own individual human memory**.

The Mid-Term Exam is graded out of a possible **150 points**, and will contribute to **15%** of your **final grade**, as per the **syllabus**.

**This exam is timed**, so don't start it until you are ready. If you loose your Internet connection **the timer is still running**, so just log back into Canvas (perhaps on another computer that is working) and begin the exam again. You will continue where you left off. Students typically take less than half the time allowed for this exam to take it, so don't rush and re-check all your answers before you submit the exam at the end.

**You can ask me clarification questions:** If you are not sure of what I'm asking or meaning try to reach me in my office at [REDACTED] (voice mail messages will be emailed to me) or [email](#) me.

You **must** use the [Proctorio plugin](#) for Chrome along with a camera and microphone and you must show it your photo ID. If possible, it is a good idea to minimize (hide) the video of yourself that may show on your screen **so you won't be distracted**. Remember **only I, your instructor**, have access to the recording of you taking this exam.

Step 3: You will be given other guidelines to be followed during the exam, It will also notify you about your laptop’s battery percentage and free space available on your laptop or desktop.

Your microphone • Your webcam • Your physical location • Your identity • Your clipboard • Your mouse location • Your browser size • Your browser tabs and windows • Your head movements • Your eye movements • Your mouth movements • Your entire screen • Any website you visit • Any other applications running • Number of display screens connected







To do that, click on the **Shield Icon**, on the right hand side of the navigation bar.




Select **“Live Chat”**.




Then Select “**Next**”.

## Identification Card

Show a photo ID to the camera within the area indicated. This will be used to validate your identity. If this is unsuccessful a link will appear. Simply click the link to manually scan a photo of your ID.





## What a Proctored exam would look like.


Your Proctored exam will look something like this with a **Quiz Tool Box** on the left hand side of your screen.





### QUIZ TOOL BOX:


1. You can see your recording on the Quiz tool box.
