#### Discussion Detail

1. <u>Presentation</u>: Paul Downs presented an overview of ALLIES (Alliance for Language Learners' Integration, Education and Success) and their role as part of the Silicon Valley Allies Innovation Initiatives. He was joined by Jennifer Splansky and David Phillips. ALLIES goal is to connect immigrant workers requiring English language acquisition, work readiness and career-technical training to high-need regional career pathways through a structured multi-sector network. Immigrant English learners make up a large growing portion of Silicon Valley's workforce. ALLIES geographic region includes San Mateo and Santa Clara counties. A collective impact method is employed which brings together cross sector partnerships, including adult education, community colleges, business community, labor unions, community programs and agencies. WWG members shared program goals and specific projects as related to the ALLIES project. ALLIES initiative supports both the goals of basic skills and workforce development as they relate to our college and to our region as a whole.
